## 1. Living and Non-living Parts of an Ecosystem

- A. Ecosystems
  - 1. Your back yard is an ecosystem
  - 2. Ecosystem all the living and non-living things in an environment
  - 3. Can be large as a forest, small as a water drop
- B. Living Parts of an Ecosystem
  - 1. Animals and plants are living parts
  - 2. They interact in many different ways

Example - trees give shelter to birds/birds spread seeds

- C. The Non-living Parts
  - 1. Soil, water, sunlight and air

Example -flowers need water, soil and sunlight

- 2. Bugs and worms tunnel and help get water and air into the soil
- D. You're part of an Ecosystem
  - 1. You are part of the ecosystem where you live
  - 2. It affects you the air, water, food you eat
  - 3. You affect it plant something, don't pollute

## II. Habitat

- A. Habitat
  - 1. A habitat is a place where an animal or plant lives
  - 2. Habitats provide shelter, water and food for living things

Example - A whale's habitat is the ocean
